



1. How are both flexibility and student choices provided for the following presentation features in the instructional materials?

- **Fonts — Type and Size:** We provide a browser-based service that allows users to customize the zoom level of the text.
- **Colors and Background Colors:** We provide a browser-based service that allows users to customize settings using their browser.
- **Background — High Contrast:** High-contrast color settings are available. We provide a browser-based service that allows users to customize settings using their browser.
- **Text-to-Speech Tools:** TCI has a text-to-speech option in both English and Spanish within our Student Licenses for all programs.
- **All Images Have Alt Tags:** TCI provides alt tags for images.
- **All Videos Are Captioned:** All TCI videos are captioned, and transcripts are available upon request.
- **Text, Image Tags, and Captioning — Refreshable Braille Displays:** Text, image tags, and captioning are available and can be sent to devices and tools, including refreshable Braille displays.

2. How are the following navigation features provided in the instructional materials?

- **Non-Text Navigation Elements (Buttons, Icons, etc.) — Adjustable Size:** We provide a browser-based service that allows users to customize the zoom.
- **Keyboard Shortcuts for All Navigation Elements and Menu Items:** We provide a browser-based service that allows users to customize settings using their browser.
- **Navigation Information Sent to Refreshable Braille Displays:** We provide a browser-based service that allows users to access content as allowed by their browser.

- **Highlighters in Four Standard Colors (Yellow, Rose, Green, Blue):** TCI provides highlighters in six colors, including the four standard ones (yellow, rose, green, and blue).
- **Highlighted Text Extracted to Another Document:** All student highlights can be exported to a PDF file.

- **Note-Taking Tools for Students:** Online note-taking tools are provided within the TCI Student Licenses.
